Our work around the world.

Operating from five hub locations in the **United States, Thailand, India, Colombia, and Brazil**, The Exodus Road has been involved in freeing more than 6,000 survivors of trafficking and arresting over 2,000 perpetrators in over 20 countries since 2012. We address the global trafficking crisis through three proven programs: Prevention, Intervention, and Aftercare.

Prevention

We educate vulnerable communities, organizations, and everyday citizens, supporting them to understand trafficking and protect against the crime in their own lives. We know trafficking can begin with a false job offer on social media, with a child being groomed, or with a parent who has no framework for the digital world their kid inhabits. Our programs equip the people closest to the problem with tools to interrupt it.





Intervention

We train and support law enforcement in their efforts to identify victims of human trafficking, build effective cases, free survivors, arrest traffickers, and dismantle criminal networks at local, national, and international levels. Our investigators work alongside law enforcement from the first tip to the final arrest, providing evidence, technology, and the persistence that complex cases demand.

Aftercare

We provide trauma-informed care starting with the moment of trafficking intervention. Our trained social workers and aftercare partners meet a wide variety of unique needs. Our survivor-centered, trauma-informed approach is designed to recognize individual experiences, rebuild trust and autonomy, and create sustainable pathways to recovery.



Valentina's Story: A Thriving Survivor

When we first got to know Valentina, she was a teenage girl from Latin America who had been trafficked far from home to the Dominican Republic. Our team helped coordinate her escape and repatriation back home.

But our role in Valentina's story didn't end with the moment of freedom. She found out that she was pregnant shortly after her return home, and our team showed up with her to doctor's appointments, provided her with baby clothes, and helped repair her family home to make it more comfortable. With our team's emotional support and care, **Valentina offered testimony that led to freedom for more than 40 additional young women** who had been trafficked. She went back and finished highschool, and today she is a thriving young mother.
